We encourage members to submit an image (at least 500 pixels by 500 pixels in size) with a brief description (two sentences, or 50 words or less) and a web link if you want to include one. We will size the image and add it to our new web site. The image will be part of the gallery and also one of the changing images that are displayed on each page of the web site.
